Pool Deck Replacement You may have noticed the pool area had "caution tape" up recently. The demolition and replacement of the pool deck is underway and the beautiful new concrete decking should be completely cured by the time this newsletter reaches you. We are pleased to say it will be ready for this incredible weather we are enjoying in SoCal.

Tree Planting / Trimming — You probably have heard progress happening if you are home during the day. We have had O'Connell Landscaping our seeing our community continues to look trimmed and manicured. The trees are getting their winter trimming completed. We also have a number of new trees you may have noticed popping up all over Woodfield. O'Connell has planted over 50 trees in our community over the past 7 months. You will see more shortly, we have plans for an additional 100 to be planted before the end of this year. Keeping Woodfield looking lush and maintaining that park setting we all appreciate.

Road Resurfacing — Plans are underway for the private roads within Woodfield to be re-surfaced. This will include all the Circles- Huron, Teton, Chinook, Allegheny, Appalachian, Arrow and Bow, as well as, Chinook Drive and Allegheny Way. Blue Ridge Drive belongs to the city and is not part of Woodfield's resurfacing responsibilities. During this project you will be asked to move any needed vehicle to a designated area. Please watch your billing statement and the website for updates on the road closures as the resurfacing is completed on your street. We will need the patience and cooperation of all residents as the process is completed over a few days' time. **Watch for more info to come!**
