IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please be advised that Phase 1 of the asphalt repair/replacement project will be completed on Wednesday June 10 and Thursday June 11, 2015 starting at 7:00 A.M. and Phase 2 will be completed on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 and Thursday, June 18, 2015. Please refer to the map enclosed and pay attention to the signs posted the community.

Vehicles must be out of the area to be repaired <u>before 7:00 A.M.</u> on the scheduled day (Wednesday June 10th or Wednesday June 17th) and will not be allowed to <u>return until 4:00</u> <u>P.M.</u> the following day (Friday June 12th or Friday June 19th).

Any vehicle(s) left in the garage after 7:00 A.M. on the above scheduled days will <u>not be</u> <u>allowed to leave the garage.</u> If you need your vehicle during this time it must be moved prior to 7:00 A.M., otherwise you will not be permitted to drive your vehicle out of the community.

Any vehicle(s) left on the asphalt areas on the asphalt repair days after 7:00 A.M. <u>will be</u> <u>towed without notice at the vehicle owner's expense.</u>

Do not walk or drive in the construction area and please pay close attention to the posted signs and barricades throughout the work area. Any person caught tampering with the barricades during this time will be held responsible for any damaged asphalt. The barricades will be removed when the work is complete and it is safe to drive on.

Also, please notify your guests and personal service providers of the asphalt repair dates.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please be advised the TRASH DAY has CHANGED from every Thursday to TUESDAY for the following dates in June. Republic Services, your trash provider, will be picking up all trash bins on Tuesday June 9th, Tuesday June 16th, and Tuesday June 23rd. Please put your trash bins outside for Tuesday pick up and please be sure to take them back into your garage/back patio by end of day on TUESDAY. Neither the Association nor the Bens Asphalt will be responsible for removing your trash bins if they are left outside on Wednesday when the asphalt repairs begin.
