Be Prepared for an Emergency - www.WoodfieldPlacentia.org - Many additions have been made to the Woodfield website. Please go to the site and review "Useful Resources" tab under the "Our Community" header. When the BIG ONE (Earthquake) hits, it is NOT IF it will?, it is When it will? The website has a number of resources to help you be ready. You will find Emergency Supply Vendors you may order from, Suggested Supply Lists of items you will need, Water Purification techniques with recommend amounts of water per person. Emergency Services suggests that your family and pets be prepared for a minimum of 7-10days to be self-sufficient and survive without any first responder assistance. Are you ready?

Alert OC Staulaformed

Alert OC is a mass Notification System designed to keep Orange County Residents and Businesses informed of emergencies. This system is utilized by the Police and Fire Department for time-sensitive alerts. They are able to pinpoint exact structures that maybe affected and get a notice to you at once! With so many of us moving away from land-line and living in a mobile society, this system is designed to give alerts where we live and work. If you are care-giver to someone residing at a different address, you are encouraged to sign up at that address so you may be their helping hand. This will give you any notices you may need relevant to that geography.

The notice may be sent to your home, cell or business phone. Text messages may also be sent to cell phones, e-mail accounts and hearing impaired receiving devices. AlertOC is a joint County/City program and they will not share your information or spam you. However they do test the system each year. www.AlertOC.com

Nextdoor.com- This is a FREE social network site that helps neighbor's share and connect: information, safety concerns, get recommendations, sell or give away items, find a lost pet, share local events.
